



#### Step 1: Getting Started

- On any computer go to Amazon.com and login with the account that is connected to your Kindle.
- In a separate tab go to the Deerfield Public Library website at <http://www.deerfieldlibrary.org>.
- Click on the **My Media Mall** link located on the bottom right hand side of the page.
- Click on the **Sign In** link on the upper right hand side of the page.
- Sign in by selecting **Deerfield Public Library** and entering your library card number.

#### Step 2: Selecting a Title

- Search for a book on the top left, or on the bottom left hand side of the page, locate the **Collections** heading and click on the **View Kindle Books** link.
- Select a title from the list of Kindle eBook titles.
- If available, click on the **Add to Cart** link. Otherwise, you can select the **Place a Hold** and receive an email when the title is available.
- After selecting a title, click on the **Proceed to Checkout** link.

#### Step 3: Downloading a Title

- Press the **Confirm Check Out** box.
- Press on the **Get for Kindle** box.
- This should open up a new browser page from Amazon.com.
- Press on the **Get Library Book** box in the green box in the upper right hand corner of the page.

#### Step 4: Transferring a Book to your Kindle (or iPad, or iPod Touch)

- Go to the **Manage Your Kindle** page at Amazon.com.
- Your library book should be at the top of the list.
- Transfer the book to your Kindle (or iPad, or iPod Touch). This will require a Wi-Fi connection. If you only have a 3G connection you will need to transfer the book via a USB cable.
- Your library book should now appear on your Kindle or in your Kindle app on your iPad. Enjoy!
