



The first time you download an eBook you need to download the free Overdrive app and active your free Adobe ID account.

- Go to the Deerfield Public Library website. <http://www.deerfieldlibrary.org>
- On the bottom right hand side of the page click on the link to My Media Mall.
- On the bottom left hand side of the page look for the “Digital Software” links and click on the link for Adobe Digital Editions.
- Click on the “Get Adobe Digital Editions” box to download the free software.
- Follow the instructions on the Adobe Page to install the free Adobe Digital Editions software and get an Adobe ID.
- Connect your Nook to your computer. You should be asked to sync your Nook device to your Adobe ID. You should only have to do this the first time you set this up.

After you’ve installed the software on your computer you can download eBooks and transfer them to your Nook.

- Go to the Deerfield Public Library website and then My Media Mall.
- Search for a book on the upper left, or on the bottom left hand side of the page look for the “Collections” links and click on the “View all Adobe EPUB eBooks” link.
- Select a title from the list of EPUB eBooks titles.*
- If it is available press on the “Add to Cart” link. Otherwise, you can “Place a Hold”.
- After selecting an available title, press on the “Proceed to Checkout” link.
- Sign in by selecting “Deerfield Public Library” and entering your library card number.
- Press on the “Confirm Check Out” box.
- Press on the “Download” box.
- The book will now automatically download into the Adobe Digital Editions software. Once the book is downloaded press on the picture of the book to begin to read it.

To transfer a book to your Nook.

- Connect the Nook to your computer using the Nooks USB cable.
- Make sure you are in the “Library” view of Adobe Digital Editions by clicking on the book shelf icon on the top left hand side.
- You should see whatever titles you have downloaded to your library from My Media Mall. You should also see an icon for your Nook on the left side of the page. Click and drag on whatever title you wish to transfer to the Nook, drag the title on top of the Nook icon, and the book should transfer to your Nook.

* A good tip is to click on the “Advanced Search” link at the top of the page. In the format option select “Adobe EPUB eBook”. In the “Subject” option you can choose a genre such as “Fiction, Mystery, or Politics” if you would like to narrow your search. You will see a box that you can check to “Only show titles with copies available”. Click on this box and only titles that are currently available to check out will be shown.
