January completes the first month of the 2020 Fiscal Year. The benchmark used to evaluate financial activity year to date is 8%.

GENERAL OPERATIONS – REVENUES

By the end of January, the Library received 0 in property tax distributions, which is 0% of the annual budget. The Library has collected 3,275 in Charges for Services, which is 8% of the annual budget. The Library received a Total Income of 13,435 or less than 1% of the annual budget.

GENERAL OPERATIONS - EXPENSES

By the end of January, the Personnel Expense is 204,531 or 7% of the annual budget. The Facility Expense is 21,610 or 12% of the annual budget. The Library Materials Expense is 108,905 or 19% of the annual budget. The Library Program Expense is 2,646 or 5% of the annual budget. The Automation Expense is 17,010 or 5% of the annual budget. The Professional/Contractual Services Expense is 3,041 or 2% of the annual budget. The Supplies Expense is 3,103 or 7% of the annual budget. The Training/Development Expense is 2,527 or 6% of the annual budget. The Facility Improvement Expense is 7,763 or 13% of the annual budget. Total Library Expenses is 371,135 or 7% of the annual budget.

When the Library receives property tax distributions, the funds are distributed to the General and Debt Service accounts.





Deerfield Public Library End of Year Liability for Accrued Payroll and Compensated Absences As of December 31, 2019

Library management is required to report the payroll liabilities to the Library Board as of the close of the fiscal year and this information is to be included in the minutes. The Library's total payroll liability for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019 is \$170,920. This is more than the amount reported as of 12/31/2018 (\$165,388) because of additional staff that have accrued sick-leave payout. \$152,700 is current and expected to be paid out within the next year, and \$18,220 is a long-term liability.

The payroll liability consists of two parts: 1) the accrued payroll liability, which is wages and taxes not paid as of December 31st, and 2) compensated absences still outstanding.

1. Accrued Payroll Liability

This is the amount due to employees for work completed. For example, if there are three days from the end of December included in the second paycheck in January, the pay for those three days is the Library's 'accrued payroll liability' at 12/31. All of this part of the liability is current and it is paid out quickly in January.

The pay checks dated 01/04/2020 included work from 12/13/2019 through 12/26/2019 and the amount owed for those 14 days was \$79,822. (See ^(a) in the formula below.)

2. Compensated Absences Liability

'Compensated Absences Liability' is for the leave time earned, payable, and not yet used by employees. It is the sum of all leave earned (such as vacation, personal days, and holidays), plus the sick days that are eligible to be paid out upon termination if the employee (who must have been hired before 1/1/2008) and at least 55 years in age. The Library has 36 employees eligible for leave benefits and 1 of those is also eligible for the sick days payout benefit.

The total amount owed for all compensated absences is \$91,098. \$72,879 of this is expected to be paid out within a short time and is a current liability (b). It includes the entire amount due for known upcoming separations, plus 80% of the amount due to all other employees. The remaining amount \$18,220, is a long-term liability (c) and is an estimate of the leave time that will be carried over for use farther into the future.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Adult Services Report

Melissa Stoeger, Head of Adult Services

- The library renewed most of the online databases this month. The following were discontinued: Today's Science (Facts on File), Little Pim (Mango) and Scholastic Trueflix due to low interest. In addition, staff closely evaluated the usage statistics for Proquest Global Newstream (one of the most expensive databases) and found that the numbers were both very low and possibly inaccurate. As a result, the library downgraded from the Global Newstream to the National Newstream and were able to add Fold3 (a military genealogy database) and Newspapers.com, and saved over \$1,000.
- Staff added a few new items to the LOT collection this month that should be very popular: a mini Sega Genesis console with 30 preloaded games; an Instax printer (which is a mini photo printer that connects to a mobile phone via Bluetooth)
- The blog post about the Library of Things got people excited about new things available. The post reached 584 people and received 42 reactions, 2 comments, and 2 shares.



- Added a new Romance Kindle that will contain only romance novels. This will allow access to some of the romance novels that are only being published in ebook now.
- Successful programs this month: 50 attendees for the Antiques Appraisal, 62 for Professor Moptop and 58 for Trivia Night.
- Staff continue to add new patrons to our Books to Go program. Chase went to Gidwitz to help a couple set up their DVD player so they could check out movies from the library!
- "An elderly patron sought me out to tell me how nice Sam was when she was looking for a movie. She felt bad because she didn't know how to use the computer to find things, but said that Sam never made her feel stupid and was very friendly and helpful."
- Our Local History archive now has 2,160 items digitized and had 371 visitors this month.
- 19 programs, 380 participants (not including RWB)
- We have 43 people signed up so far for the 2020 RWB program.
- Participation in the yearly Grammy contest dropped in half this year. Last year there
 were 62 patron entries. This year, there are 30 entries.

IT & Social Media Report

Tom Owen, Head of IT

- Staff has nearly completed the transition from 3M's Command Center platform to the new Bibliotheca LibraryConnect cloud based platform. This software manages and provides reporting for connected Bibliotheca devices such as the self checks, inductions, and security gates. One key feature is that Info Desk staff will now be able to see a popup on their PC of materials that set off the gate instead of having to scan items individually.
- The Windows 7 to Windows 10 migration is anticipated to be completed in the next two weeks.
- New RFID pad installation begins at staff workstations on 2/11. The new hardware provides improved reliability and ease of use for staff.
- Staff will begin a site survey to determine WiFi coverage in the building. The goal is locate dead zones and areas where signal can be improved. We will use this data to refresh and relocate existing WiFi access points to better serve patrons and staff. The current access points were installed 7 years ago with the building's renovation.

Support Services Report

Pam Skittino, Head of Support Services

- Pam started the process to implement three new products (Scheduler, Online patron registration, and Express Lane) in our catalog to help streamline the work load.
- In January, Innovative Interfaces was purchased by Ex Libris, a ProQuest company, and has become a business unit of Ex Libris. They have offered assurances that our investment is protected and that the products we currently use will continue to be developed. We infer that we will be assigned a new sales rep but that is the only sign of immediate change. Ex Libris largely handles academic library software so they want to develop the ability to handle multi-library-type consortia using the Inn-Reach product which we already use to run the LINKin catalog. Ex Libris is still developing hosted services and SaaS (Software as a Service) for their customers with a two year timeline we are already hosted thru AWS Cloud Services so we are ahead in this aspect.

Youth Services Report

- Four programs were canceled in January due to lack of staffing.
- With their many outreach and in-library storytimes and other programs, Kary led 26 programs in January and Julia led 25 programs in January.
- Meg reviewed 38 applications for the Youth Programming Coordinator position. Of those, 6 were identified for phone interviews, then 3 for in-person interviews. The goal is to have someone in place before the end of February.
- Nina is working with Judy and Jamie to coordinate the Summer Reading Logo with the DHS design class students. This is the sixth year of this partnership.
- A group of kids came made capes for their Destinations Imagination project in the MakerSpace. The photo made 720 impressions and received 25 total engagements. Picture below:





