

Say farewell to 2020 and overdue fines!

A new era is on the horizon for Deerfield Public Library patrons — the Fine Free era!

For the past two years, Library staff has researched the pros and cons of overdue fines, including potential usage barriers, efficiencies, and the Library's bottom line. A first step in this direction was the launch of automatic renewals, which decreased our overdue fine collection.

Still, of our 16,301 active cardholders (DPL cardholders and reciprocal borrowers), 1,408 cards are blocked because they have more than \$10 in fines and fees. Of these cards, 497 are adult cards and 668 are youth cards.

After careful consideration, the Deerfield Public Library Board of Trustees voted to eliminate charging overdue fines. This action will further support the Library's commitment to open access.

How will this work? Following is a brief overview, and full details will be shared on our website, social media, and e-newsletter closer to the launch date.

Note: Due to COVID-19, the Library has not actively collected fines since early

March 2020. In preparation for the switch over on December 1, we are in the process of

retroactively eliminating fines, though replacement bills will remain on accounts.

Timetable for notices in the Fine Free era will be as follows:

2 days **before** due: Courtesy notice will be received (email and text only).

2 days **overdue**: Notice sent.

7 days overdue: Notice sent.

14 days overdue: Notice sent.

21 days overdue: Notice sent and card is blocked. Until items are returned, patron will be unable to place holds, check out any materials, including the digital collection, or use the MakerSpace.

28 days overdue: **Billing Notice** sent for full replacement cost of item(s).

If you currently have any overdue items at home, we would love to have you return them before December 1. With the continued quarantine of materials, the sooner you return your items, the sooner another patron will have access.
