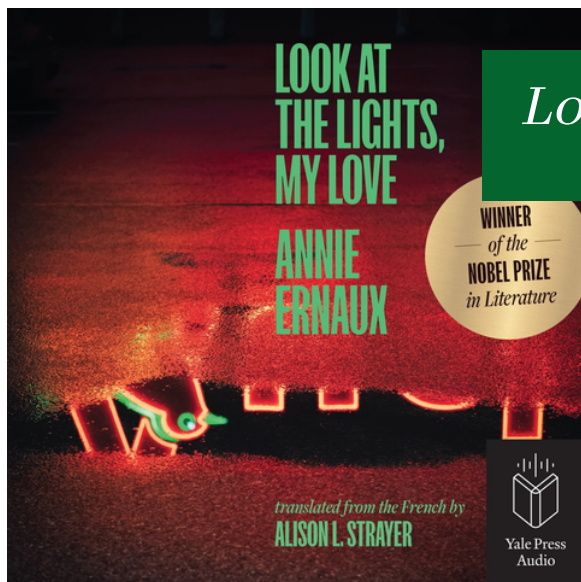

## *Look at the Lights, My Love*

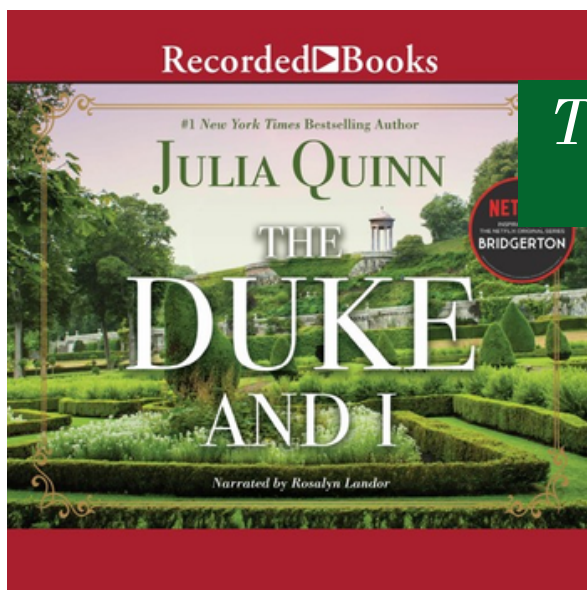
Annie Ernaux

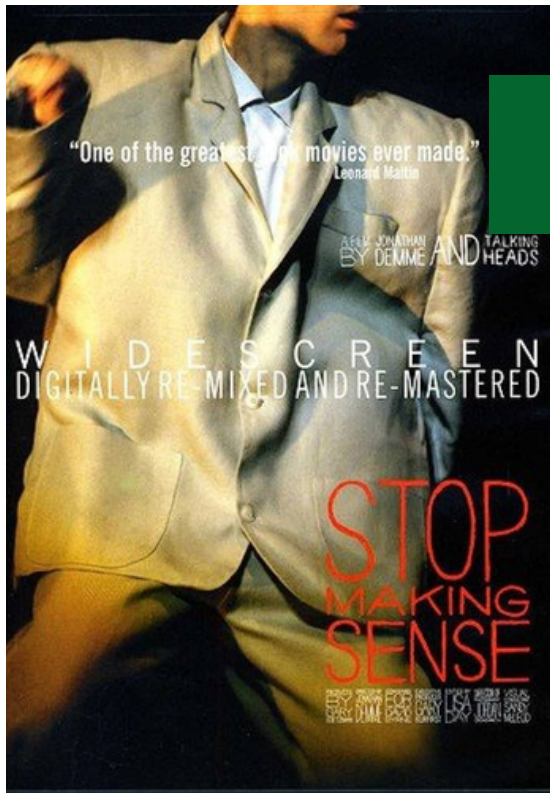
*Red, White, & Royal Blue re-inspired my love of reading. Its a great book overall. ~Elizabeth S. (CW: sexually explicit scenes).*

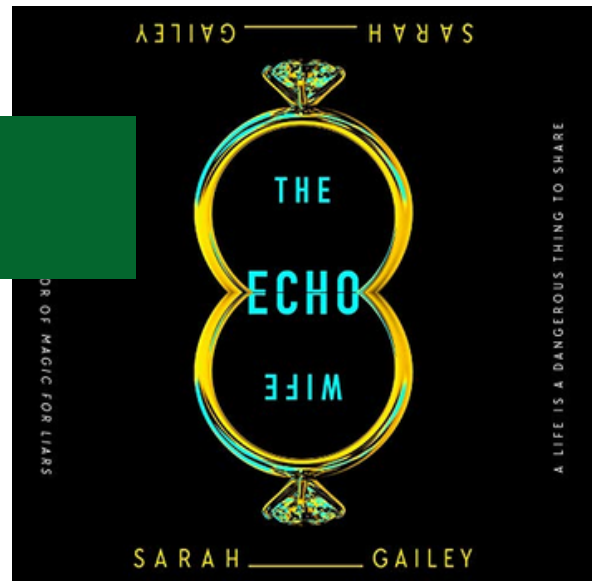

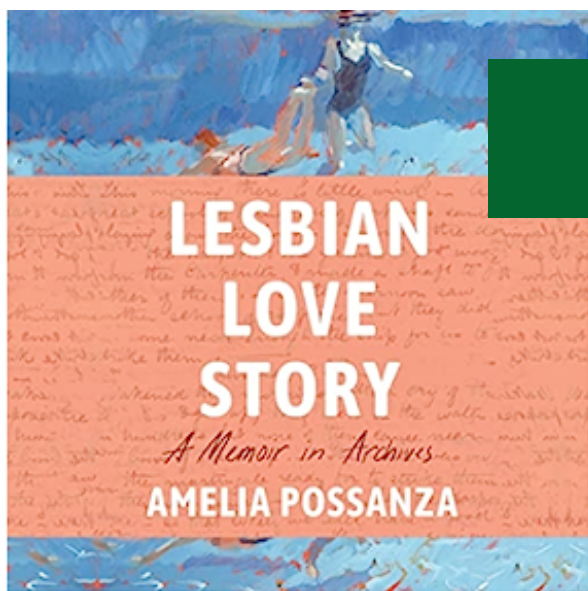
