the Deerfield Public Library!**



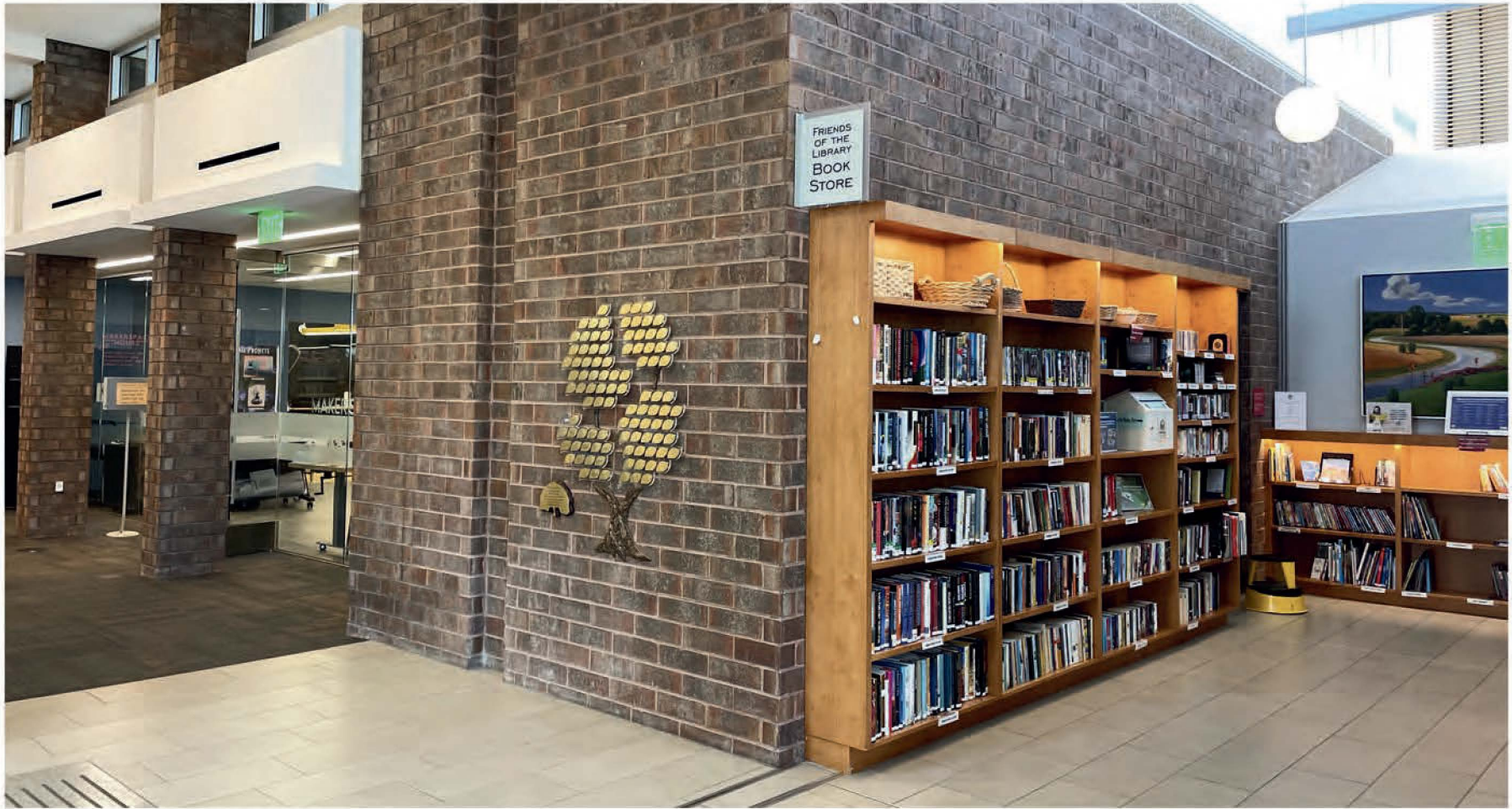
I can park at an accessible spot.

In the MakerSpace, I can work on my craft projects, use the technology, and ask MakerSpace staff for help.



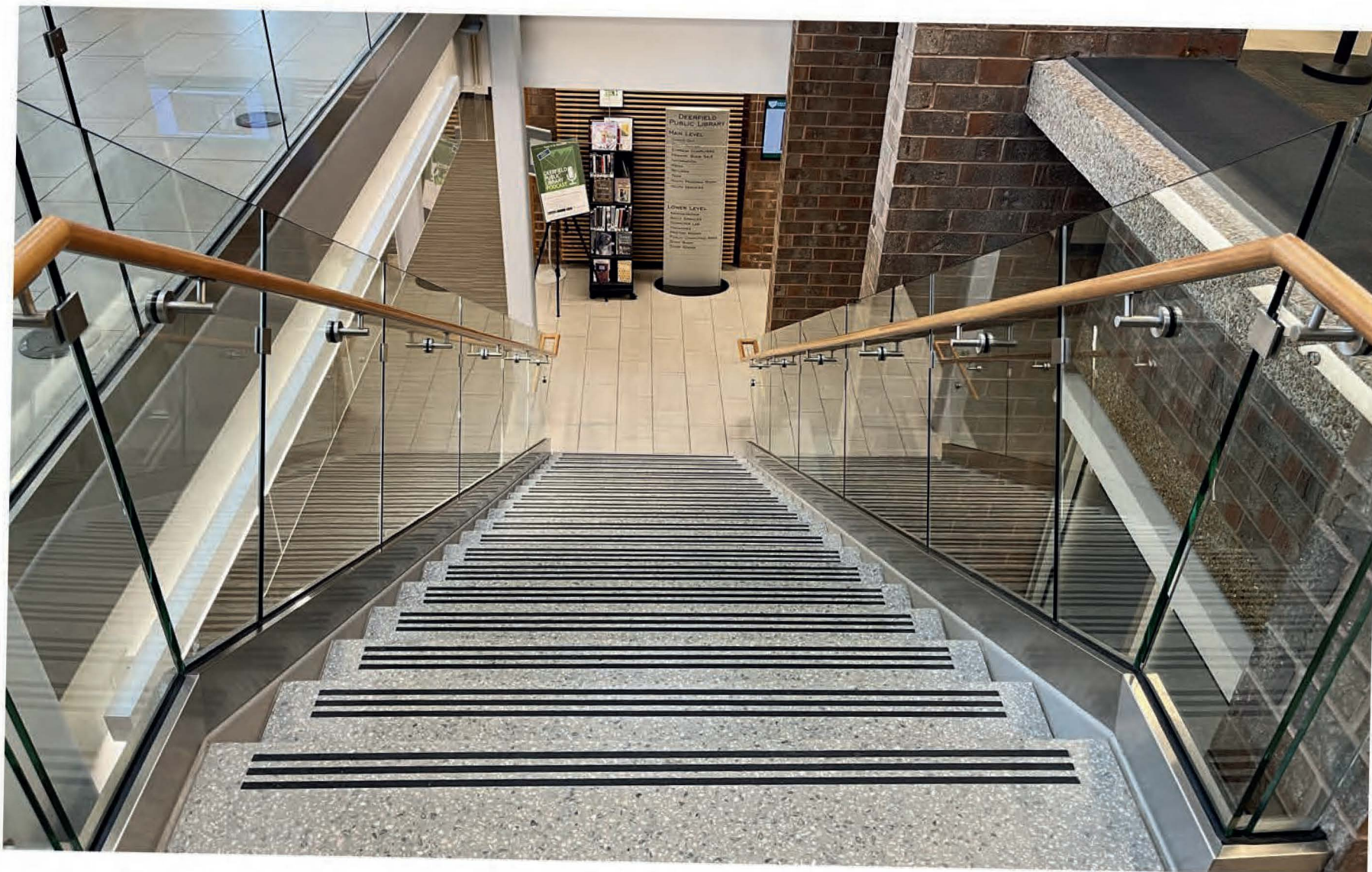
**In the MakerSpace, I can reserve

I can go downstairs to visit the Adult Services Department.



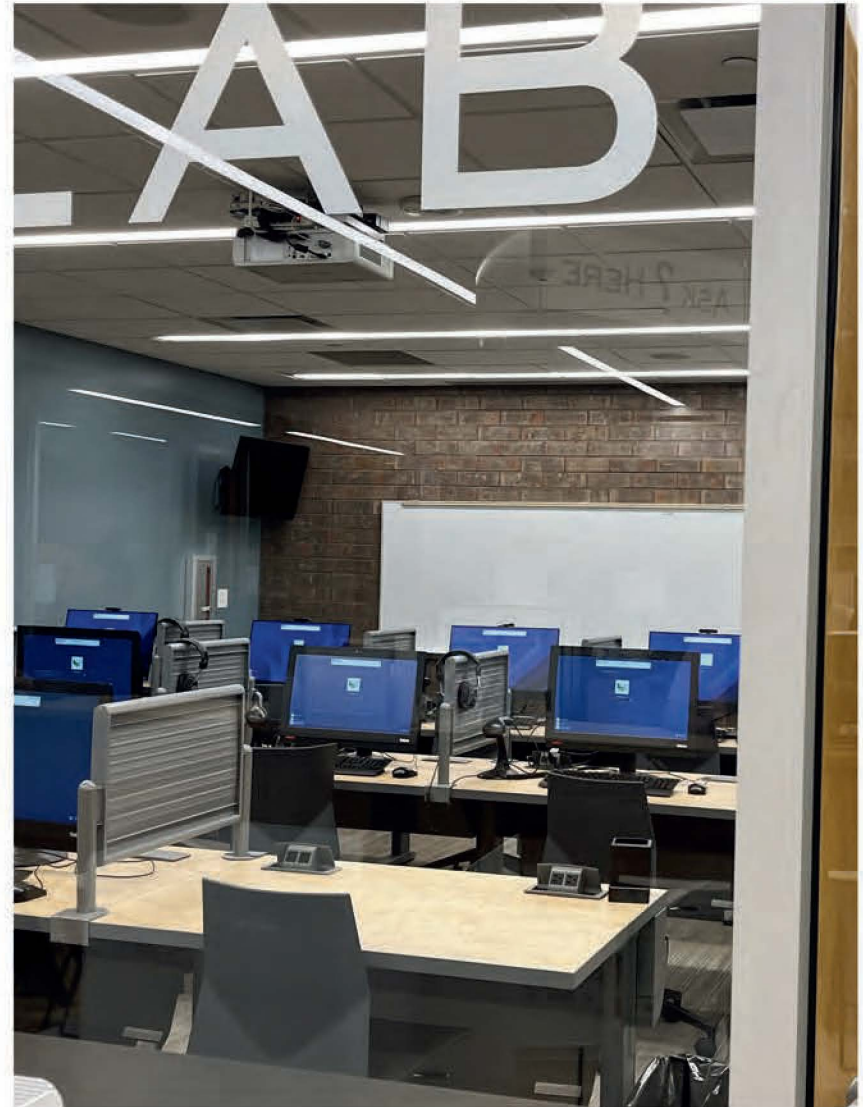
I can also take the elevator downstairs to the Adult Services Department.

Use a computer, print, and make copies.**



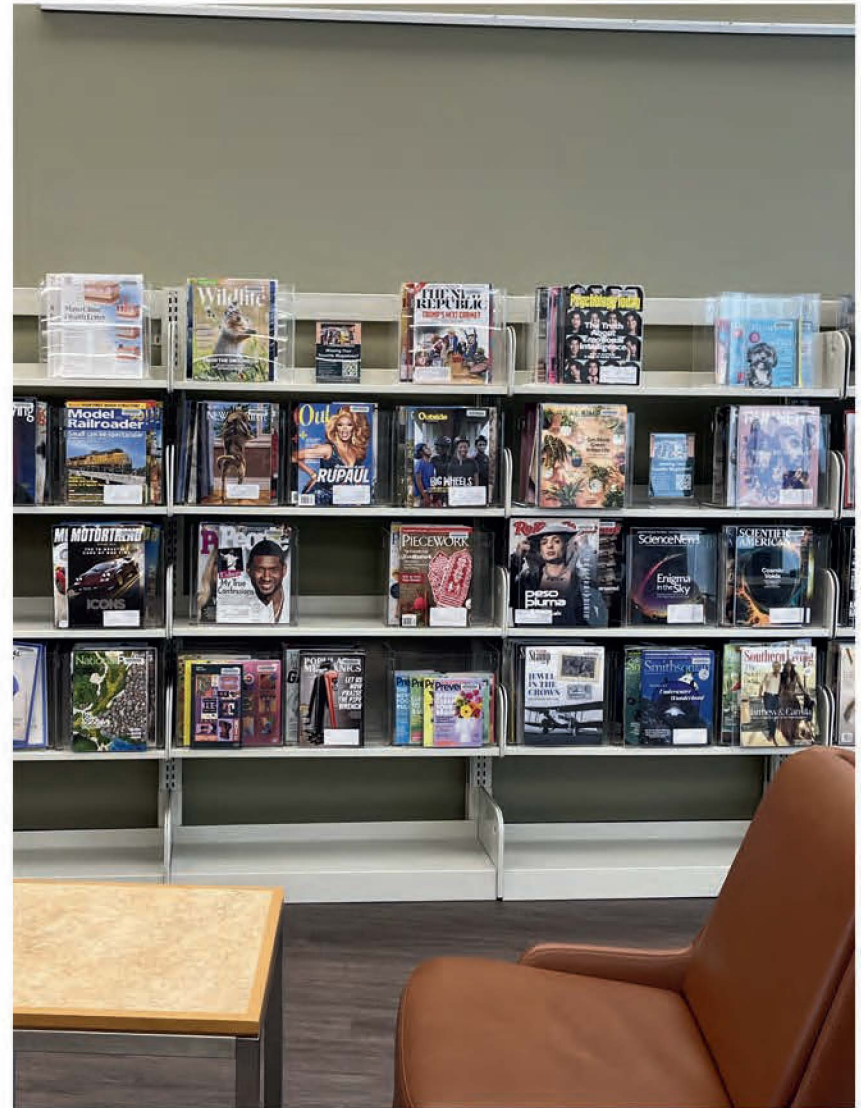
In Adult Services I can... Look up items on one of the catalog computers.

Find many, many books!**



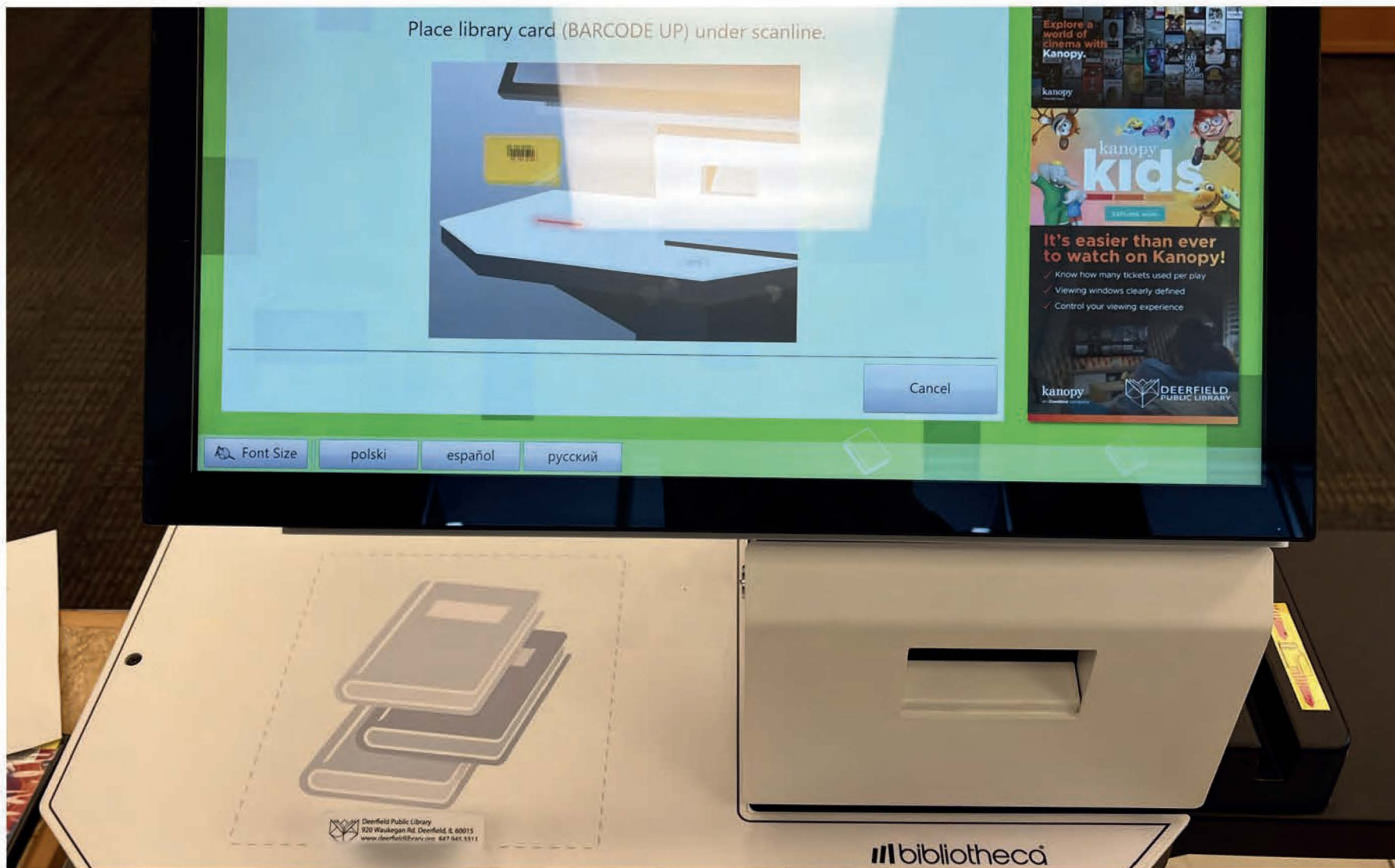
In Adult Services I can... Work or read quietly in the Quiet Room. I can also read magazines.



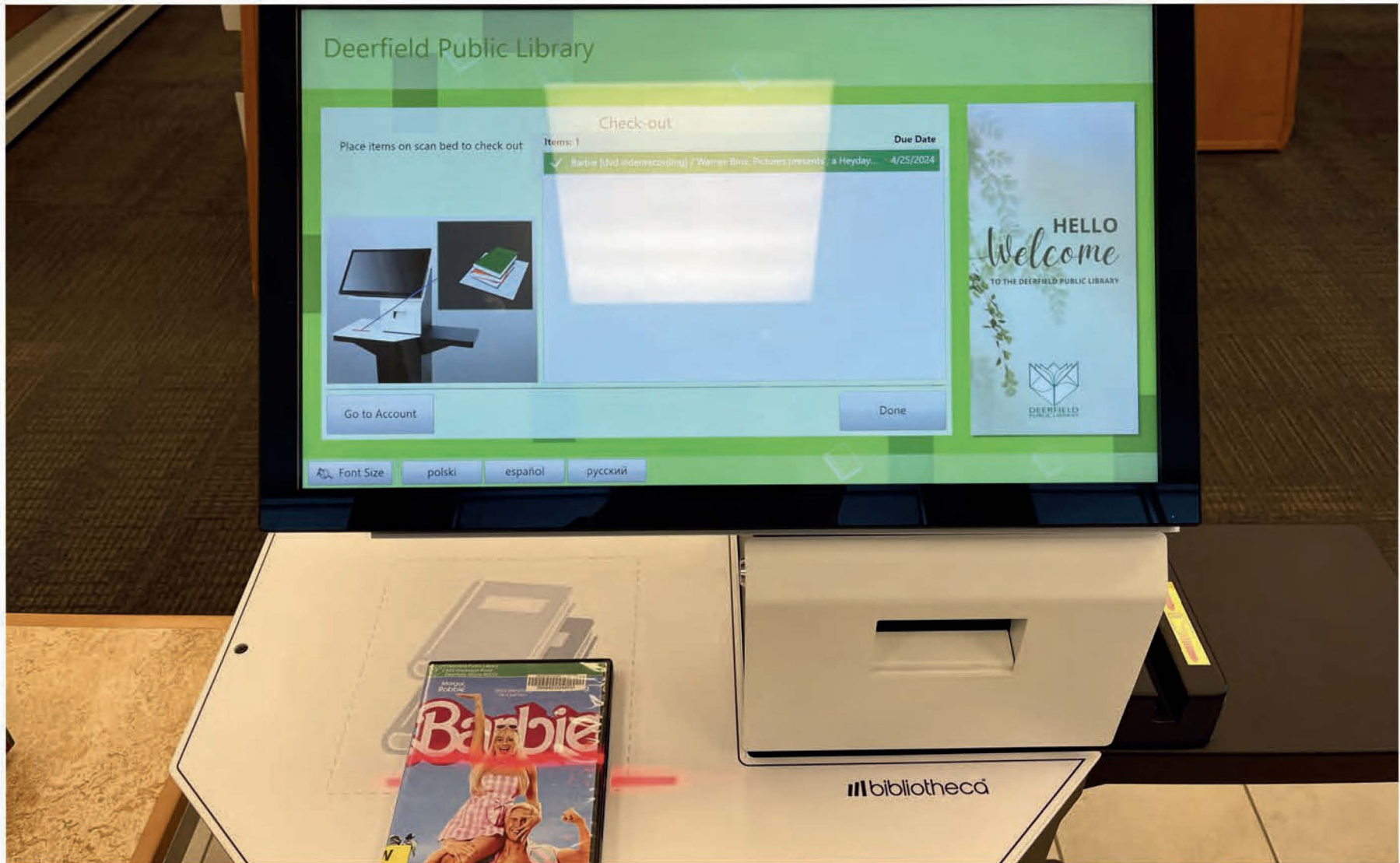
At the Library I can... Check out books, audiobooks, CDs, DVDs/Blu-rays, board games, and more!
